

## A lot of files ...

A lot of popular website packages are shipped as Zip archives, or .tar.gz archives, which is nice, because you download everything with one click, don't you?

Generally these systems rely on many modules or sub-modules, as well as additional images (.gif, .jpg, .png), Flash movies, CSS files and Javascript, PHP, ASP, JSP scripts.
